The Metro Desk Reporter will be responsible for daily reporting and long form enterprise and investigative reporting, with an emphasis on covering the diverse communities of the Providence metropolitan area. This is a full-time position with benefits. The Metro Desk Reporter reports to the Daily News Editor.

Duties include:

- Enterprise/Investigative Reporting: Generate ideas, pitch stories, and report long-form stories on issues affecting the communities of Providence, Central Falls, Pawtucket and surrounding collar communities
- News Reporting: Coverage of daily news for broadcast and digital channels, including spots, short features
- Web page: Write and post web stories; maintain Metro Desk page and any special project pages
- Collaboration: Collaborate with journalists at The Public's Radio and other news organizations as appropriate
- Community Engagement: Participate in community partnerships and events as assigned
- Fund-raising: Participate in regular on air fund drives as assigned
- Other duties as determined by the Chief Content Officer
